for Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Projects

About 300 lenders across the state – banks, savings institutions and credit unions at nearly 900 locations can offer Dollar and Energy Saving Loans. You can find all eligible lenders at neo.ne.gov.

The Nebraska Energy Office and its lending partners have offered Dollar and Energy Saving Loans for more than 20 years. Since 1990, in excess of \$250 million have financed more than 26,000 individual projects. Nearly 93 percent of the projects have been made in the homes of Nebraskans for replacement of inefficient furnaces, air conditioners and heat pumps, replacement of windows and doors, insulation of walls and ceilings as well as ENERGY STAR® appliances.

Eligible projects and ones that require an audit, interest rates, loan maximums and other particulars are listed at neo.ne.gov.

Most Dollar and Energy Saving Loan applications are reviewed and processed within ten working days, if all information has been submitted by the applicant and their lender.

The steps to getting a loan for prequalified projects:

1. Get an estimate and any specifications required for your project
2. Complete the application form for the project you are planning
3. Find a lender
4. Lender submits application to Energy Office
5. Energy Office reviews application
6. Lender notifies you project loan approved/ not approved

Steps for projects requiring an audit or for energy efficient housing loans are different and can be found on the applicable project application form.

You are not eligible for a loan if you start or complete the work before your lender receives a signed commitment from the Energy Office on your proposed project.
