Weatherization Installer Intermediate

This five-day class covers building science theory and construction methods as well as exercises and techniques for installation of weatherization materials. This course will focus on hands-on application of weather-stripping, insulation, mechanical ventilation, caulking, door and window installation. Included is difficult weatherization procedures such as basements and crawl spaces.

A state of the art 44' mobile trailer will be utilized to deliver this hands on training program.

Agenda:

- ↪ Understand thermal and air barriers and develop recognition to repair the gaps in air pressure and thermal barriers.
- ↪ Air leakage principles and be familiarized with the tools, materials preparations required for air sealing and insulation of a house.
- ↪ In-depth knowledge of understanding the advantages, limitations and safety issues of various insulation materials.
- ↪ Maintain healthy air quality
- ↪ Proper guidelines and process in insulating walls, ceilings and floors.
- ↪ Weatherizing basements and crawl spaces
